

**Job title: Research Associate**

The Division of Outcomes and Effectiveness in the Department of Public Health at Weill Cornell Medical College is seeking a Research Associate to collaborate with investigators in the Division to perform analyses related to health policy and medical care. Division investigators have extensive federal and foundation grant funding for policy-relevant research on topics including pay-for-performance and public quality reporting, physician practice organization, hospital readmission policy, and electronic health record implementation.

The Research Associate will create analysis plans, develop and share data cleaning techniques, prepare analytic databases, perform statistical analyses, and prepare and communicate study results. The Research Associate will also coordinate data management and analysis operations among Division investigators and supervise the work of programmers.

Qualified applicants must have a PhD or Master's degree in statistics, biostatistics, economics, health policy, or a relevant discipline. Experience with SAS programming and working with medical claims data is required. Knowledge of health policy and medical care is a plus.
