

# Alumni Award of Distinction 2025

## Weill Cornell Graduate School of Medical Sciences

## Ting Jia "TJ," Ph.D. '08

Dr. Ting Jia (Ph.D. '08), also known as "TJ," is the founder and managing partner of Octagon Capital Advisors, an investment fund focused on health care. He earned a bachelor's degree in biological sciences from Sun Yat-sen University in China and completed a Ph.D. in immunology at Weill Cornell Graduate School of Medical Sciences.

Dr. Jia brings extensive experience and expertise across investing, consulting and biomedical research. Prior to founding Octagon, he was a managing director at Hillhouse Capital, where he led investments in the life sciences sector. He previously served as an investment analyst at BVF Partners L.P. and as a management consultant at McKinsey & Company. From 2004 to 2009, he conducted research as a fellow at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center.

He currently serves on the boards of Bluejay Therapeutics and NiKang Therapeutics. He has also served on the boards of Viela Bio and AnHeart Therapeutics prior to their acquisitions, as well as Apellis Pharmaceuticals and Gossamer Bio ahead of their initial public offerings.

In addition to his professional endeavors, Dr. Jia is co-chair of the Weill Cornell Graduate School of Medical Sciences' Alumni Advisory Council, serves on the Weill Cornell Medicine Board of Fellows' Committee on Research and Entrepreneurship, and is co-chair of the Weill Cornell Medicine's Alumni Entrepreneurship and Innovation Committee.

# **Siegel Family Faculty Awards** 2025

## Jeanne and Herbert Siegel Award for Excellence in Medical Education

## Anthony M.C. Brown, Ph.D.

Dr. Anthony Brown is an associate professor of Cell and Developmental Biology at Weill Cornell Medicine. Dr. Brown graduated from the University of Cambridge and received a Ph.D. in molecular biology from the University of Edinburgh.

Dr. Brown's research has focused on mechanisms of cell signaling in cancer biology that are also relevant to the regulation of stem cell function and normal tissue morphogenesis. His laboratory received continuous federal funding for more than 25 years. He was previously co-director of the Allied BCMB Graduate Program at Weill Cornell, and Program Director of an NIH T32 training grant in Cell and Molecular Biology.

For the past 35 years, Dr. Brown has been consistently involved in medical education at Weill Cornell Medicine and has lectured in several courses. He was an inaugural member of the faculty committee that developed, and now manages, the medical curriculum's Areas of Concentration. In 2014, he was appointed director of the Office of Medical Student Research and currently serves as course director for the Summer Research Elective Credit course and the year-long Extended Curriculum for Research program. For the past 10 years, Dr. Brown has been leader of the neoplasia unit of the course, "Essential Principles of Medicine." Among Dr. Brown's honors are the Royal Society European Science Exchange Fellowship; the Andrew W. Mellon Teacher-Scientist Award; Pew Scholar in the Biomedical Sciences, the Irma T. Hirschl Career Scientist Award and awards from Weill Cornell Medicine for excellence in teaching and medical education.

# Jeanne and Herbert Siegel Award for Outstanding Medical Research

## Tobias Meyer, Ph.D.

Dr. Tobias Meyer is the Joseph C. Hinsey Professor in Cell and Developmental Biology and a professor of biochemistry. A Ph.D. graduate of the University of Basel in Switzerland, he joined Weill Cornell Medicine in 2020.

Throughout his career, Dr. Meyer, a biophysicist, has made notable discoveries to our understanding of how cell signals control cell function. He pioneered the development of biosensors and live cell imaging and analysis methods to study intracellular signal transduction. His work on local signaling and feedback regulation led to our current understanding that the signals that control cell function vary between cells and are local and dynamic in nature.

The goal of Dr. Meyer's lab, which he shares with Dr. Mary Teruel, associate professor of biochemistry, is to identify new targets for cancer therapy and new ways to promote tissue repair. Their studies have appeared in such prestigious publications as Nature, Nature Communications, the Journal of Cell Biology and the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences. In 2023, Dr. Meyer was elected to American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

# Jeanne and Herbert Siegel Faculty Development Award

## Jane Chang, M.D.

Dr. Jane Chang is an associate professor of clinical pediatrics at Weill Cornell Medicine and section chief of adolescent medicine in the Department of Pediatrics. A graduate of the University of Vermont Robert Larner, M.D. College of Medicine, she joined the Weill Cornell Medicine faculty in 2005.

Dr. Chang has led multidisciplinary programs at New York-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center dedicated to providing comprehensive care to underserved communities in such areas as adolescent parenting, HIV prevention and pediatric obesity. She founded and leads NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center's youth gender program.

Dr. Chang has been a dedicated educator and mentor to medical students, pediatric residents and fellows in adolescent medicine throughout her career. She has delivered many lectures and published research on issues related to adolescent health.

Dr. Chang also serves as a physician champion with the NewYork-Presbyterian Division of Community and Population Health, and co-founded a pipeline program within the Department of Pediatrics to expose high school students from underrepresented backgrounds to careers in health care through mentorship and hands-on experiences.

# Dean's Award for Excellence in Mentorship 2025

### Marshall J. Glesby, M.D., Ph.D.

Dr. Marshall Glesby is a graduate of the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and completed his internal medicine residency and infectious diseases fellowship at the Johns Hopkins Hospital. He also received a Ph.D. in Clinical Investigation from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. He joined Weill Cornell Medicine in 1999 and is currently a Professor of Medicine and of Population Health Sciences, as well as Vice Chair for Mentoring and Faculty Development in the Weill Department of Medicine.

An expert on the metabolic complications of HIV disease and its therapy, he has created multiple formal mentoring structures for students, trainees, and faculty in infectious disease, both inside and outside WCM. He leads NIH-supported training programs, supports early-career faculty in the promotions process, and mentors students and colleagues at Weill Cornell Medical College, Weill Cornell Graduate School of Medical Sciences, and Cornell's Ithaca campus. He has formally mentored more than sixty researchers, co-authored more than seventy publications with trainees, and supported six mentees who have gone on to win independent research grants.

His commitment to mentorship and community outreach on the local, regional, national, and international levels is truly outstanding.

# Alumni Award of Distinction 2025

## **Weill Cornell Medical College**

## Ruth Lynfield, M.D. '85

Dr. Ruth Lynfield (M.D. '85) is the state epidemiologist and medical director of the Minnesota Department of Health, and an adjunct professor of medicine and of epidemiology and community health at the University of Minnesota. She trained in pediatrics and pediatric infectious diseases at Massachusetts General Hospital.

Dr. Lynfield has worked on the epidemiology, prevention and control of emerging infectious diseases throughout her career, and developed surveillance systems, investigated outbreaks and advised on public health policy. She has also mentored many master's students, doctoral students, infectious disease fellows and epidemiology fellows.

She has served on multiple federal public-health advisory committees, including the National Vaccine Advisory Committee, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Board of Scientific Counselors for the Office of Infectious Diseases (which she chaired from 2018-2022).

Dr. Lynfield has authored or contributed to more than 400 peer-reviewed articles and policy statements and has served as an editor for several textbooks on public health, including "Infectious Disease Surveillance" and "Public Health and Preventive Medicine." She is also an associate editor of the American Academy of Pediatrics' "Red Book: 2024 Report of the Committee on Infectious Diseases." Dr. Lynfield is an elected member of the American Epidemiological Society and has been co-chair of the CDC Emerging Infections Program steering committee since 2008. She has also served on the executive board of the National Foundation for Infectious Diseases and as the president of the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists.
